AN ACT REVIVING THE MERCANTILE WHARF CORPORATION, AND
EXTENDING THE TERM OF ITS CORPORATE EXISTENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven
2 of chapter one hundred and fifty-six of the General Laws, The
3 Mercantile Wharf Corporation shall continue to be a corpora-
4 tion for a further term of fifty years from May sixteenth, nine-
5 teen hundred and sixty-two, the date of the expiration of the
6 term of its incorporation, and shall, during such further term,
7 have the powers and privileges and be subject to the duties,
8 liabilities and restrictions set forth in its charter and in all gen-
9 eral laws relating to such corporations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of May sixteenth,
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
