AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN OFFICERS FROM THE APPLICATION OF CIVIL SERVICE RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in lines 6 and 7, as appearing in chapter 26 of
3 the acts of 1951, the words "officers whose appointment is sub-
4 ject to confirmation by the executive council;" and by inserting
5 in place thereof the words: — officers whose appointment is sub-
6 ject to approval or confirmation by the governor or the execu-
7 tive council, or by both, — and by striking out, in lines 10 and
8 11 of said section five, as so appearing, the words "officers whose
9 appointment is subject to the approval of the governor and coun-
10 cil."
