AN ACT AUTHORIZING AGENTS OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO REMEDY CERTAIN CONDITIONS CAUSED BY BEAVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by add-
2 ing after section 112C the following section: —

3 *Section 112D.* The director of the division of fisheries and
4 game or his agents authorized by him in writing may, in the
5 performance of their duties, enter upon and pass through or
6 over private lands, whether or not covered by water. They
7 may in the course of such duties remedy conditions caused by
8 beavers resulting in damage of private or public property.
