RESOLUTIONS COMMENDING REPRESENTATIVE GEORGE W. SPARTICHINO.

1 *Whereas*, On Sunday, May 24, 1964, while pleasure riding
2 with his family through the city of Gloucester, Representative
3 George W. Spartichino noticed that an eleven year old boy had
4 fallen into the Annisquam river and was in fear of drowning;
5 and

6 *Whereas*, Without hesitation and irrespective of his own
7 safety, Representative Spartichino plunged into the river fully
8 clothed and effected the rescue of this boy and thereby saved
9 his life; and

10 *Whereas*, By this heroic act, Representative Spartichino ex-
11 emplified the highest ideals of our nation by doing to others as
12 he would have others do to him and thereby brought great honor
13 upon himself, his family and his colleagues in the house of rep-
14 resentatives; therefore be it

15 *Resolved*, That the house of representatives hereby commends
16 Representative George W. Spartichino for his heroic action above
17 and beyond the call of duty; and be it further

18 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be sent forthwith
19 by the state secretary to Representative George W. Spartichino.
