AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COURT OF NORTHERN ESSEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The central district court of northern Essex hereafter shall
- 2 be known as the district court of Haverhill. Wherever used in
- 3 any statute or by-law the words "central district court of
- 4 northern Essex" shall mean the "district court of Haverhill".
