## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO SELL OR EXCHANGE CERTAIN LAND ACQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENLARGING WALDEN POND STATE RESERVATION.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to authorize the department of na-  
3 tural resources to exchange forthwith certain land acquired for  
4 the purpose of enlarging Walden Pond State Reservation, there-  
5 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for  
6 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 726 of the acts of 1960 is hereby amended by adding  
2 at the end the following sentence: — The department may, with  
3 the approval of the governor and council, sell or exchange any  
4 land acquired under this act which in his judgment can no longer  
5 be advantageously used for the purposes thereof.
