## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

### AN ACT RELATING TO THE TAXATION OF BOOKS AND THE EXEMPTION OF FLAGS UNDER THE SALES TAX LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection 6 of section 1 of chapter 14 of the acts  
2 of 1966 is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (m) and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

4 (m) Sales of newspapers, magazines, publications of any  
5 corporation, foundation, organization or institution described  
6 in paragraph (e) of this subsection, motion picture films for  
7 commercial exhibition, and flags of the United States and of  
8 the commonwealth of Massachusetts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to sales at retail made on  
2 and after July first, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
