AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION BATHHOUSE AND POLICE STATION IN THE TOWN OF NAHANT THE J. JOSEPH WARD MEMORIAL BUILDING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The bathhouse and police station to be erected by the metro-  
2 politan district commission in the town of Nahant shall be  
3 known and designated the J. Joseph Ward Memorial building  
4 in memory of the late J. Joseph Ward, deputy superintendent  
5 of the metropolitan district police department. A suitable  
6 marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by  
7 said commission.
