## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL INDUSTRIAL FISH SEINED IN THE TERRITORIAL WATERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH MUST BE LANDED AND PROCESSED IN SAID COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 130 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 104 the following section: —

3 *Section 105.* All industrial fish seined in the territorial waters  
4 of the commonwealth shall be landed and processed in said  
5 commonwealth. Whoever violates the provisions of this section  
6 shall be punished by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars  
7 or by imprisonment for sixty days, or by both such imprison-  
8 ment and fine.
