**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 12 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 662 of the acts of 1966, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the ninth paragraph and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 For the western district, an assistant district attorney, three  
6 second assistant district attorneys and four third assistant dis-  
7 trict attorneys. Three of such assistants shall reside in Berk-  
8 shire county and the other five in Hampden county.

1 SECTION 2. Section 16 of said chapter 12 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the ninth paragraph and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 For the western district, one assistant, eighty-four hundred  
5 dollars; three assistants, seven thousand dollars; and four  
6 assistants, five thousand two hundred and fifty dollars.
