AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF THE COSTS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK AMONG THE CITIES OF BOSTON, CHELSEA AND REVERE AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary the  
2 expenses of county government in the county of Suffolk,  
3 including the operation of county installations and the  
4 furnishing of county services such as the house of correction,  
5 the county jail, registry of deeds, the courts and medical  
6 examiners, shall be apportioned among the cities of Boston,  
7 Chelsea and Revere and the town of Winthrop in proportion  
8 to their respective total assessed valuations of real estate  
9 based upon their assessments for the year nineteen hundred  
10 and sixty-five.
