AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL NURSING AND PERMITTING THE REGISTRATION OF ALIENS AS NURSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section ninety-four B of chapter one hundred
2 and twelve of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section 80B of said chapter 112 is hereby am-
2 ended by striking out clause (5), as most recently amended by
3 chapter 428 of the acts of 1964, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following clause: — (5) the performance of nursing service
5 by a person authorized to practice nursing under section sev-
6 enty-six A, subject to the provisions of said section.

That the Secretary of the Interior, Department of the Interior, Washington, D. C., be and he is hereby authorized to execute and perform all the duties and functions of the office of the Secretary of the Interior, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the provisions of this act.
