AN ACT ESTABLISHING PREVAILING WAGE RATES FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of general or special
2 law to the contrary, any employee of the commonwealth who is
3 employed in any position in the trades and crafts, shall be paid
4 a salary which is equal to that paid to an employee in the same
5 trade or class in private employment. The salary shall be de-
6 termined from the official reports of the Bureau of Statistics of
7 the United States Department of Labor for cities in Massa-
8 chusetts.
