By Mr. Vigneault of Springfield, petition of the Massachusetts State Council No. 41 AFSC&ME AFL-CIO and Dave N. Vigneault that state employees be prohibited from working alone in plants where heavy equipment with moving parts is used and where noxious gases and vapors are present. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FURTHER FOR THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 inserting after section 124 the following section:—

3 *Section 124A.* No employee of the commonwealth shall be
4 permitted to work alone in any plant where heavy equipment
5 with moving parts is used, or where power is generated, or
6 where electric current of six hundred volts or more is used, or
7 in a plant where noxious gases and vapors are present.
