## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTION AND DESIGNING OF RUNWAYS  
AT LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO MINIMIZE NOISE AND AIR  
POLLUTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to design and construct runways seaward at Logan  
3 International Airport in the East Boston district of the city  
4 of Boston and to promulgate rules relative to flight patterns  
5 of airplanes arriving and departing, consistent with the safety  
6 of said airplanes, in order to minimize noise and air pollution  
7 nuisances to residents of the cities of Boston, Revere and the  
8 town of Winthrop.
