AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF  
CANDIDATES' WORKERS OUTSIDE POLLING PLACES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for clarifying  
3 the rights and duties of candidates' workers outside polling  
4 places, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,  
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public conven-  
6 ience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 65 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:—

4 No person shall hinder, delay or interfere with, or aid in  
5 hindering, delaying or interfering with, a voter within one  
6 hundred and fifty feet of the entrance of a polling place intend-  
7 ing to influence the action of the voter while on his way to a  
8 primary or election.
