AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABSENT VOTING BALLOTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 89 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 368 of the acts of 1966, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following sentence: — All
4 postage for the return by the absent voter of his ballot shall be
5 prepaid by the respective cities and towns and for the postage
6 thus paid in a biennial state election, the city or town treasurer
7 shall bill and be reimbursed by the state treasurer for the postage
8 paid.
