RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF ESTABLISHING A FIVE MAN COMMISSION FOR URBAN APPEALS CONSISTING OF TWO REAL ESTATE BROKERS, TWO ARCHITECTS AND AN ATTORNEY.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representatives  
3 and four persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study  
5 relative to the advisability of establishing a five man commission  
6 for urban appeals consisting of two real estate brokers, two  
7 architects and an attorney for the purpose of granting to those  
8 property owners whose rights are threatened by the inclusion of  
9 their property in a proposed urban redevelopment area the right  
10 to appeal the proposed taking of their property with particular  
11 reference as to making the determination of the commission  
12 binding on local urban redevelopment or housing authorities  
13 and as to establishing standards for the commission and any  
14 other related matters.
