By Mr. Khachadorian of Arlington, petition of Gregory B. Khachadorian for legislation to require eyeglasses and sunglasses to be fitted with plastic lenses or tempered or casehardened lenses. Public Health.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT EYEGLASSES AND SUNGLASSES BE FITTED WITH PLASTIC LENSES OR TEMPERED OR CASEHARDENED LENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 270 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 2B the following section:—
3 *Section 2C.* No person shall fabricate, distribute, sell, ex-
4 change, deliver or have in his possession with intent to dis-
5 tribute, sell, exchange or deliver any eyeglasses or sunglasses
6 unless said eyeglasses or sunglasses are fitted with plastic lenses
7 or tempered or casehardened lenses; all such lenses to be of not
8 less than 2 M M minimum thickness. Any person violating
9 the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not
10 less than one hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-eight.
