AN ACT DEFINING LICENSEES UNDER RETAIL INSTALLMENT SALES AND SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 255D of the General Laws as added
2 by chapter 284 of the acts of 1966 is hereby amended by add-
3 ing after the definition of "official fees" the following defi-
4 nitions:—

5 "License," when used in sections seven and eight, shall in-
6 clude the right to engage in the business of a sales finance
7 company whether or not a license is required under section
8 two.

9 "Licensee," a person engaged in the business of a sales
10 finance company pursuant to this chapter whether or not such
11 person is required to obtain a license under section two.
