**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE POLLS FOR VOTING BE KEPT OPEN FROM EIGHT O'CLOCK ANTE MERIDIAN TO EIGHT O'CLOCK POST MERIDIAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, the
- 2 hours during which the polls shall be kept open for voting
- 3 in all primaries and elections shall be from eight o'clock ante
- 4 meridian to eight o'clock post meridian.
