In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS IN CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
2 A of chapter five hundred and thirty-six of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and sixty-six, any clerk or assistant clerk of
4 a district court who was appointed to any said office between
5 July first, nineteen hundred and sixty-six and January fourth,
6 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, both dates inclusive, shall
7 receive such salary as is provided by section seventy-nine and
8 section eighty of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the
9 General Laws, said salary to be effective as of the date of his
10 appointment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
