### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROTECTION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN FROM MEASLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 15 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 15A.* No child shall be admitted to school except
- 4 upon presentation of a physician's certificate that said child has
- 5 been vaccinated against measles. The vaccine shall be supplied
- 6 free of charge by the commonwealth.
