### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL JUSTICE IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT, DORCHESTER DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 561 of the acts of 1965, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following new sentence:— Each dis-  
5 trict court, other than the municipal court of the city of  
6 Boston, shall have one justice, except that the district court  
7 of Springfield, municipal court of the Roxbury district, the  
8 first district court of eastern Middlesex and the municipal  
9 court of the Dorchester district shall have two justices each,  
10 and the third district court of eastern Middlesex and the  
11 central district court of Worcester shall have three justices  
12 each.
