AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PERSONNEL APPEALS BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 54 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof
3 the following new sentence:— There is hereby established a
4 full-time personnel appeals board which shall consist of three
5 members who shall have expert knowledge and skill in the field
6 of personnel administration and industrial relations and who
7 shall not hold any other office or position, appointive or elec-
8 tive, in the service of the commonwealth.
