AN ACT RELATIVE TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR CITIES, TOWNS, COUNTIES AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THE MAKING OF EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS TO, RENOVATIONS OR ALTERATIONS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the definition "approved school project", as  
3 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 703 of the acts  
4 of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the following definition:—  
5 "Approved school project" shall mean any project for the  
6 construction or enlargement, the making of extraordinary repairs  
7 to, renovation or alterations of a regional, consolidated or county  
8 agricultural school, or of any public schoolhouse in any city or  
9 town, and shall include the original equipment and furnishings,  
10 whether movable or built in, to complete said project, the con-  
11 tract or contracts for which, in the case of construction or en-  
12 largement, shall have been awarded on or after January first,  
13 nineteen hundred and forty-six, and in the case of extraordinary  
14 repairs, renovations or alterations shall have been awarded on  
15 or after January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, which  
16 have been approved for the purposes of sections seven through  
17 nine.
