AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE THE GRANTING OF SPECIAL LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second sentence of section 14 of chapter 138 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by section 11 of chapter
3 444 of the acts of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:— Special licenses for the dispensing of wines and malt
5 beverages in premises maintained by incorporated educational
6 institutions authorized to grant degrees may be granted by the
7 local licensing authorities in such a city or town to such insti-
8 tutions; provided, that such beverages shall be served only to
9 persons over twenty-one years of age.
