The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FUNDS IN THE INLAND FISHERIES AND GAME ACCOUNT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The state treasurer shall transfer to the inland
2 fisheries and game fund a sum equal to one dollar for each
3 original license issued under the provisions of section eight of
4 chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the General Laws, as
5 amended, for purposes which would include the payment of
6 interest and payments on account of principal of bonds issued
7 under the provisions of chapter six hundred and fifty-one of
8 the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to
2 prohibit the use of these funds for federal matching pro-
3 grams.

1 SECTION 3. The effective date of this act shall be July first,
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
