AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WARMING UP OF AIRCRAFT AT THE GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No aircraft shall be permitted to warm up at the General
- 2 Edward Lawrence Logan International Airport between the
- 3 the hours of twelve midnight and eight antemeridian.

The Commission of Enquiry

1. The Commission shall be constituted in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
2. The Commission shall have the right to call for and examine any documents or papers which may be necessary for the purpose of its inquiry.
3. The Commission shall have the right to summon any person who is likely to be able to furnish information in relation to the subject-matter of its inquiry.
