**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A SMALL CLAIMS  
ACTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 496 of the  
3 acts of 1964, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 11,  
4 the words "one hundred and fifty dollars", and inserting in  
5 place thereof the words:—three hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on October first,  
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
