AN ACT REGULATING THE USE OF MOTORBOATS AND REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION THEREOF ON CERTAIN WATERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 14 of chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out subsection (b) and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following subsection:—

4 (b) Whoever violates any provision of sections five, seven,  
5 nine B or twelve or of any rule or regulation pertaining thereto,  
6 shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than  
7 fifty dollars.
