### AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE PROBATIONARY PERIOD FOR POLICE PATROLMEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Secion 20D of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 255 of the acts of 1961, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting at the end of the first sentence  
4 in the first paragraph the following new sentence:— No per-  
5 son shall be considered a permanent patrolman until he has  
6 actually performed the duties of that position for a probation-  
7 ary period of one year.
