## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL AND STANDARDIZATION TO RECOMMEND RE-EVALUATION OF EVERY POSITION AND OFFICE IN THE COMMONWEALTH AND SUBMIT SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GENERAL COURT EVERY TEN YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 45 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following para-  
3 graph:—

4 Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary  
5 contained in this section, the director of personnel and stand-  
6 ardization shall re-evaluate every position and office in the  
7 official position and classification plan and recommend re-  
8 allocation of any position or office which he deems advisable.

9 All such recommendations shall be submitted to the general  
10 court in the year nineteen hundred and seventy and in every  
11 tenth year thereafter.
