AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A PUBLIC AUTHORITY IN THE CITY OF WOBURN TO BE KNOWN AS THE WOBURN GOLF AND SKI AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 A public authority hereinafter referred to as the authority  
2 is hereby established in the city of Woburn. The authority  
3 shall be appointed by the mayor, six members to be life  
4 members and three to be five year terms.

5 Said authority shall be authorized to establish a ski and  
6 golf business in the city of Woburn. The mayor and tax title  
7 custodian shall be authorized to convey property and real  
8 estate known as Woburn Country Club consisting of ninety-  
9 six acres more or less and buildings thereon and also ten acres  
10 on the northeast slope of Horn pond mountain and ski  
11 equipment and buildings thereon.

12 Said authority shall also be authorized to acquire adjacent  
13 privately owned lands, borrow money, sell bonds for capital  
14 improvements, hire whatever employees are necessary to run  
15 ski business and golf club said employees not to be governed  
16 by civil service rules and regulations.

17 All profits derived from said activities of the authority  
18 shall be deposited in the general fund of the city of Woburn  
19 Treasury. All books and records shall be audited each year by  
20 the state auditor.
