AN ACT REGULATING THE COLOR OF ALL MOTOR VEHICLES FOR HIRE
USED IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 199 of the acts of 1963, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out clause (6) and
4 inserting in place thereof the following clause:—(6) All
5 school bus bodies and vehicles used in the transportation of
6 school children for hire shall be painted a yellowish orange
7 color similar to what is commonly known as "national school
8 bus chrome", except that fenders and trim may be black.
