## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS TO VOTE BIENNIALLY TO ALLOW BLITZ OR BEANO GAMES IN CLUBS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 If a majority of the voters in a city or town vote in the  
2 affirmative the licensing authorities of said city or town may  
3 issue permits to "clubs" duly chartered under chapter one  
4 hundred and eighty of the General Laws.

5 Said clubs shall be required to conduct said "blitz" or  
6 "beano" on their own premises staffed by personnel from their  
7 own membership rolls. All revenue derived from these ac-  
8 tivities shall be deposited in the charities account of their  
9 club treasury.

10 No "club" will be permitted to hire personnel on a per-  
11 centage of gross or profit basis to run said blitz or beano ac-  
12 tivities.
