AN ACT DEFINING THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 142 of the General Laws as appearing
2 in section 2 of chapter 358 of the acts of 1965 is hereby
3 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following sen-
4 tence:— Plumbing as the term is used herein includes only
5 the work, practice, materials and fixtures used in the instal-
6 lation, maintenance, extension and alteration of systems in-
7 volving potable water, sanitary sewage, venting or storm drains
8 within the walls of a building.
