RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO POLICIES CONCERNING GOVERNMENTAL EXPENDITURES AND FISCAL POLICIES.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president  
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be  
4 designated by the speaker thereof and two persons to be  
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the  
6 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to  
7 policies concerning governmental expenditures and fiscal  
8 policies, especially as these pertain to cities, towns, and  
9 counties with reference to metropolitan areas. Said commis-  
10 sion shall be provided with quarters in the state house or  
11 elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require by summons the  
12 attendance and testimony of witnesses and the production of  
13 books and papers, may travel within and without the  
14 commonwealth and may expend for legal, clerical and other  
15 expenses, such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said  
16 commission shall report the results of its investigation and  
17 study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts  
18 of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into  
19 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of  
20 representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of De-  
21 cember in the current year.
