AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ESSEX COUNTY MAY BORROW TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A COURT HOUSE IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL FOR THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COURT OF NORTHERN ESSEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 140 of the acts of 1963 is

3 inserting in place thereof the word:— eight hundred fifty.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 140 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in line 4, the word "five" and inserting in
3 place thereof the word:— eight hundred fifty.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
