AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL SCHOOL AID TO CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any city or town which, in the year nineteen hundred and
2 sixty-six, did not receive an amount of school aid which
3 amounted to one hundred and fifteen per cent of the amount
4 paid by the commonwealth to each city and town in nineteen
5 hundred and sixty-five, as provided by chapter fourteen of
6 the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six, shall be reim-
7 bursed for such deficit from the revenues provided by said
8 chapter fourteen in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-
9 seven.
