By Mr. Long of Fall River, petition of John J. Long that persons sixty-five years of age or over be granted free fishing licenses. Natural Resources.

AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS FROM THE PAYMENT OF A FEE FOR FISHING LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Clause (1) of section 8 of chapter 131 of the General Laws,
- 2 as most recently amended by chapter 466 of the acts of 1959,
- 3 is hereby further amended by striking out the last paragraph
- 4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
- 5 No fee shall be charged for any license issued under this
- 6 clause to a person who has attained age sixty-five or for a
- 7 fishing license issued under this clause to a person who is a
- 8 recipient of old age assistance granted under chapter one
- 9 hundred and eighteen A, to a person who is blind, or to a
- 10 person who is a paraplegic.
