AN ACT ALLOWING CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR VETERANS FOR MILITARY SERVICE DURING WARTIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after subsection 8 the following subsec-
- 3 tion:—
- 4 9. To allow the present members of the retirement system
- 5 to establish creditable service for military duty during
- 6 wartime. To make payments for said military service based
- 7 on salary earned during first year of employment with the
- 8 commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof.
