### AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP IN A RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision (*H*) of paragraph 1 of section 5 of chapter 32  
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
3 following subparagraph:—

4 Any member who was appointed while serving in the  
5 armed forces between January first, nineteen hundred and  
6 forty and July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, shall  
7 have credited as creditable service towards retirement the  
8 period beginning as of the date of such appointment and  
9 ending as of the date of his discharge or release from military  
10 service.
