RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MARINE BIOLOGY AND COMMERCIAL FISHERIES COURSES AT A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of
3 representatives and four persons to be appointed by the gov-
4 ernor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an in-
5 vestigation and study relative to the advisability of establishing
6 courses in marine biology, commercial fisheries, marine engi-
7 neering, biological and physical oceanography, processing of
8 frozen fish and seafood products and other related matters at a
9 state institution of higher learning.
