AN ACT REQUIRING THE TEACHING IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE USE OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 14 of chapter 572 of the acts of 1965, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Such schools
5 shall be taught by teachers of competent ability and good morals,
6 and shall give instruction and training in orthography, reading,
7 writing, the English language and grammar, geography, arith-
8 metic, drawing, music, the history and constitution of the
9 United States, the duties of citizenship, physiology, and hygiene,
10 good behavior, indoor and outdoor games and athletic exercise,
11 and use of natural resources.
