AN ACT TO RELOCATE CERTAIN HARBOR LINES IN NEW BEDFORD HARBOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 1 of chapter 80 of the acts
2 of 1929, as amended by section 1 of chapter 95 of the acts of 1946,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 48 and 49,
4 the words "one thousand seven hundred eighteen and nine
5 tenths" and inserting in place thereof the following:— Three
6 hundred and seventy feet to point E, in latitude five thousand
7 one hundred twenty-nine and ninety-six one hundredth feet
8 north and longitude one thousand five hundred sixteen and
9 thirty-four one hundredths feet west; thence north thirty-one
10 degrees, fourteen minutes, forty-five seconds west, true bearing,
11 three hundred twenty-two and twenty-eight one hundredths
12 feet to point E in latitude five thousand four hundred five and
13 forty-nine one hundredth feet north, and longitude one thousand
14 six hundred eighty-three and fifty-one one hundredths feet
15 west; thence north twenty degrees, seventeen minutes, fifty-
16 one seconds west, true bearing, nine hundred fifty-two and
17 forty-five one hundredths feet to point E₃ in latitude six thou-
18 sand two hundred ninety-eight and seventy-nine one hundredths
19 feet north and longitude two thousand thirteen and ninety-one
20 one hundredths west; thence north seventy-two degrees, forty-
21 three minutes east, true bearing, two hundred forty and sixty-
22 six one hundredths feet to point E₄ in latitude six thousand
23 three hundred seventy and twenty-nine one hundredths feet
