## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION FOR JURORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 25 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 613 of the acts of 1966, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence:—The compen-  
5 sation of traverse jurors impanelled to try cases of murder  
6 in the first degree shall be eighteen dollars, and that of all  
7 other traverse jurors and of grand jurors sixteen dollars, for  
8 each day's service.
