AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REMUNERATION OF CHEMISTS AND BACTERIOLOGISTS EMPLOYED BY CERTAIN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of general or spe-
2 cial law, upon its acceptance any city having a population of
3 fifty thousand or more, except the city of Boston, which em-
4 ploys chemists and bacteriologists under the civil service regu-
5 lations, and which accepts this act, as hereinafter provided,
6 shall adopt the remuneration plan, grade for grade, currently
7 in effect, for chemists and bacteriologists in the employ of the
8 state department of public health.
