AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES USED IN THE SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM IN HIGH SCHOOLS DURING CERTAIN HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13D of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 349 of the acts of
3 1963, is hereby further amended by inserting after the second
4 paragraph the following paragraph:—

5 Motor vehicles used in such courses which are owned by
6 said towns shall not be used during the period commencing
7 with the end of the usual school hours and the beginning of
8 the evening courses.
