**AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP OF CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT
BOARDS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1945, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting in the ninth line, after
4 the words "third member" the following words, — who shall
5 not be an employee or official of the commonwealth or of any po-
6 litical subdivision thereof, nor a person retired by and re-
7 ceiving a pension or retirement allowance from the common-
8 wealth or any political subdivision thereof, nor a person hold-
9 ing public office to which he has been elected by direct vote of
10 the people, and.

1 SECTION 2. Section 16 of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1945, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting in the tenth line, after
4 the words "third member," the following words: — who shall
5 not be an employee or official of the commonwealth or of any po-
6 litical subdivision thereof, nor a person retired by and receiving
7 a pension or retirement allowance from the commonwealth or
8 any political subdivision thereof, nor a person holding public
9 office to which he has been elected by direct vote of the people,
10 and.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (b) of subdivision (3) of section 20
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as added by section 1 of
3 chapter 658 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting in the eighth line, after the words "third member,"
5 the following words: — who shall not be an employee or official
6 of the commonwealth or of any political subdivision thereof,
7 nor a person retired by and receiving a pension or retirement
8 allowance from the commonwealth or any political subdivision
9 thereof, nor a person holding public office to which he has been
10 elected by direct vote of the people, and.

1 SECTION 4. Paragraph (b) of subdivision (4) of section 20
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as added by section 1 of
3 chapter 658 of the acts of 1945, is hereby amended by inserting
4 in the ninth line, after the words "third member," the following
5 words: — who shall not be an employee or official of the com-
6 monwealth or of any political subdivision thereof, nor a person
7 retired by and receiving a pension or retirement allowance
8 from the commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof,
9 nor a person holding public office to which he has been elected
10 by direct vote of the people, and.
